

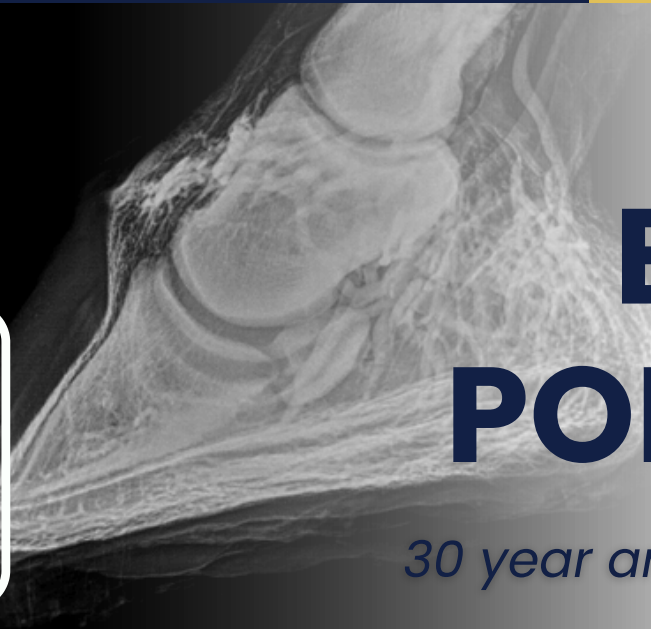

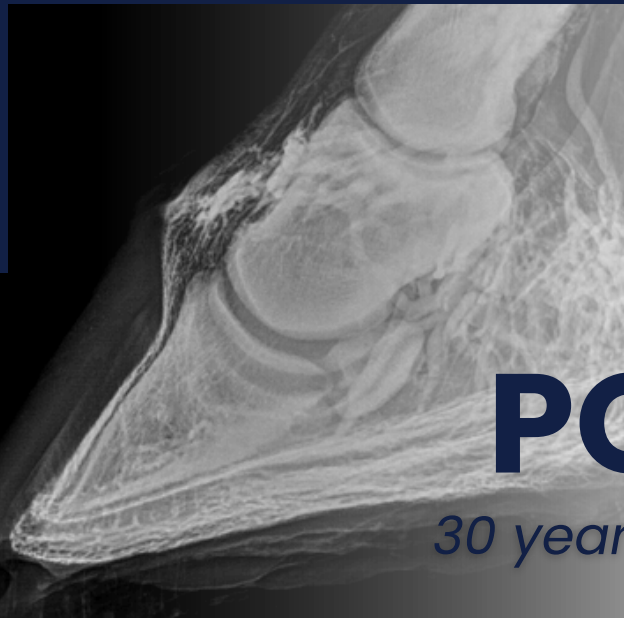

7:15AM WELCOME & JUDGES INTRODUCTION

(White Park - Guernsey St, Scone)

8AM EVENT 1: SHOERING

- Shoe a pair of fronts with $\frac{3}{4}$ fullered toe clip shoes out of 32/12mm flat bar stock. Nails to suit.

Time: 70 minutes

EVENT 2: FORGING

- Make a $\frac{3}{4}$ fullered front out of 32/12mm flat bar stock with a 16mm toe grab welded on as per specimen. E10 nails.
- Make a scotch heel hind out of 32/12mm flat bar stock as per specimen. 8-1/4" long toe to both heels. E10 nails.

Time: 70 minutes

EVENT 3: TEAM RELAY EVENT

- Make a plain stamp deep seated straight bar shoe out of 25/12mm flat bar stock. Each team member gets 10 minutes at the anvil. No fireman, striker allowed. Hammer finish. E7 nails. Hot start

Time: 30 minutes

- Shoe a pair of hinds with $\frac{3}{4}$ fullered shoes from 32/12mm flat bar stock. Nails to suit.

- Make a Shire yearling bevel out of 7/8x7/16 concave as per specimen. E7 nails.
- Make a preventer roadster hind out of 25/12mm flat bar stock as per specimen. E6 slim nails.

Competition Rules

ENTRIES CLOSE: 21 MAY 2026

- The competition is a team event comprising of three people (fireman/striker, shoemaker, floor person).
- Each member is permitted to perform any of the above tasks.
- Only one hoof to be worked on at a time.
- The three members entered as a team are to remain as a team for the duration of the event.
- Involvement for any non-team members is not permitted at any time, with the exception of a horse holder for live shoeing events.
- Competitors are to supply their own tools.
- Time limits will be strictly adhered to. On completion of the events allowed time, shoes must be placed on the anvil and all work on the foot to stop.
- In the result of an equipment failure the affected team are to signal the steward. Their time will be stopped and restarted once the issue has been resolved. (This excludes hand tools).
- Any technique seen to be detrimental to the horse's welfare will not be permitted as determined by the judging officials.
- Any people on the competition floor or using the cut-off saw MUST wear safety glasses at all times.
- Each team is to organise their own horse holders.
- All events are hammer finished.
- In the shoeing events the competing teams will start in a staggered start format at four-minute intervals.
- Forging classes will be judged in a 'table' style format.
- Points will be scored in an accumulator style format with the maximum number of points available per event being dependent on the total number of teams competing.

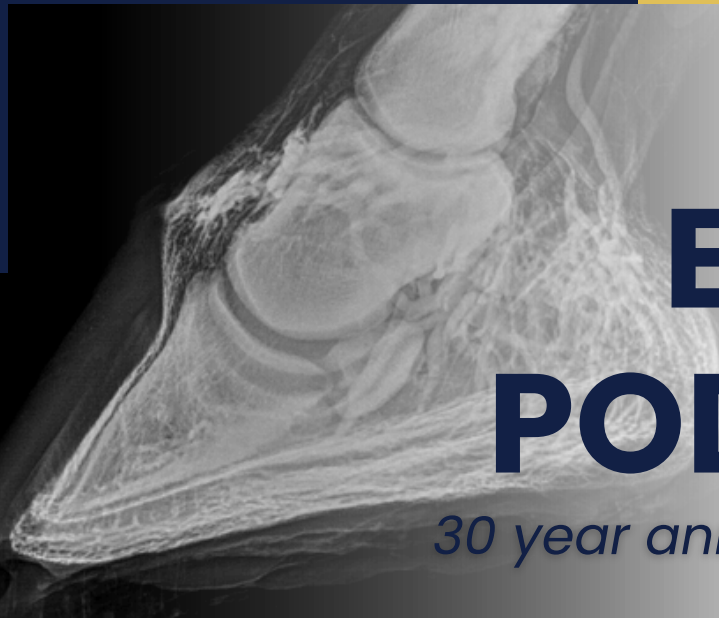
